Assignment # 3:

Audio Slideshow (worth 25% of your final grade)

Choose a unique person or interesting business you feel will provide not only a good story, but also will be visually appealing. You will be profiling the business or person using photos and audio (roughly a 1 1/2 to 2 minute piece, think about your online audience, there is no magic number but you don't want a story to drag).

You will be graded equally on the story/narrative and the photos accompanying it. Remember, bad audio will hurt your project significantly! If for some reason, the audio failed the first time go back and do the interview again correctly. Do not wait until the last minute to complete this assignment, it will require some major time, please plan accordingly. You should visit your subject several times.

Deadlines: *Friday, September 26* - Post to blog a 5-10 sentence pitch about your audio slideshow story and bring a printed version to class
Friday, October 17 (1st version posted to our class blog for in-class critique) &
Friday, October 24 (**final version due**)

Turn in the following:

(1) A dvd containing:

- The full take of the photos in a "Raw" folder
- The edited final version of the audio slideshow exported to a mov file and re-name this file to: Last_first(Name)_slideshow)

(2) Post audio slideshow to the class blog, with 2-3 paragraphs explaining your challenges/successes

(3) Complete the Self-Evaluation Form, turn in both an electronic (copy on your cd/dvd) and a printed version when submitted.
